### Things to Know Before Document Submission

- All documents must be original and must be written in English. The original notarized copies translated into English or Korean will be accepted. Should they be unavailable, copies must be validated/attested/notarized by the issuing institution or a notary office.
- After completing the online application, the required documents must arrive at the Graduate School Office by the designated deadline by fast shipping (DHL or EMS).

Proof of Funds (Must be original copies)	Submit at least one of the documents listed below to prove your sponsorship described on the application form. (Minimum amount of \$20,000) 1. Bank statement in your name showing the balance of the account (dated within 30 days from the application date) 2. Your sponsor (your parents)'s bank statement and a document indicating the relationship between you and your sponsor (dated within 30 days from the application date) 3. Proof of external scholarship covering your tuition and living expenses

- ※ Students from certain countries may be required to submit additional supporting documents for a visa application to the immigration authority.
- ※ In accordance with Korean visa policy announced by the Ministry of Justice, Proof of funds must be submitted when receiving visas in Korea.
